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WHAT IS TALES AROUND TOWN?



HOW DOES IT WORK?

The key is flexibility!

20-30 MINUTES OF STORYTIME + ACTIVITY OR TOUR

*The follow up activity or tour really depends on the location

Examples: putting greens at the golf course

seeing where the pizzas are made at local pizzeria

mini toddler-friendly obstacle course at local gym



TUESDAYS AT 10AM + SEPT - MAY

*Made all asks for the entire year in August, then sent out reminders to the host locations as the date got closer

*Give attendees plenty of notice with a <u>calendar for the entire year</u>

Themes relate to location. We use a <u>storytime databse</u> to help reduce planning time before each storytime.





I'm working on a new storytime series for this school year called "Tales Around Town", where I take storytime out into the community weekly on Tuesday mornings instead of having it in the library. This is partially motivated by the possibility the library might have to close sometime for the renovations later this year. It is also to try and give some of our littles and their caregivers new experiences around town as a part of their early literacy learning.

CONNECTIONS

Witness relationships blossom between attendees, both children and caregivers

Turns hosts into library advocates

Starts relationships for other program opportunities with the hosts

PUBLICITY

More people understand what storytime involves and what it is all about, less fear of the unknown

Great PR and return benefits to hosts, they get their message out and see people they might never get through their doors

INCREASED ATTENDANCE

Reaching new people with every new location

More people know about storytime in the community and are talking about it, including bystanders

Avg. 40-45 in attendance per wk

Attendees now go to our other program offerings

Used it to replace our least attended weekly storytime program


